

Keyworth Camera Club – Online Photo Entry System – DPIs & Prints

Login / Register

- You should have received an email with a link to the website. Initially you will have been given a temporary password until you changed this to one of your own.
- Go to <https://compent.photoentry.uk/compent> and **login**. If you have forgotten your password, there is an option to retrieve it on the login page.
- There is a good **help guide** on the PhotoEntry website, answering some FAQs.

How do I submit an entry?

The basic steps are:

1. From the Main Menu select the relevant **Season**. This will hold all the competitions for a particular year.
2. Select the **Competition** you are entering. You can only submit / change / delete entries when the Competition is Open. *In the example Round 1 is 'open' for entries, whereas Round 2 is not yet open.*

3. Check the **number of entries** that you are allowed for the Competition/Event. The number of entries varies but for a Club Competition will usually be 3.

Add New Entry

4. **Export your images as JPGs** from your photo software / camera. Pay attention to the **image dimensions**, and the **colour space** (see FAQs). However, the system will adjust this for you if required. You can upload a JPG that is upto **10MB**.
5. Click on **Add New Entry**.
6. Supply a **Title** for the image (there are some characters that you can't use - eg "&"). Make sure you check your title, as it will be displayed as you have entered it. You can also add an Entry Reference if you wish, just for your own records. Click **Add This Entry** and then upload your image.
7. Once the messages for the Entry are **green (OK)**, your entry is accepted. You may still have a warning about image dimensions (see FAQs).

8. **Add further entries** if you want to and have not already reached the limit.

9. It is important you put your images in **order of preference** (1 being the highest) as if any category has too many entries, the lowest ranked images will be deleted first. When you have uploaded your entries, if you want to **change their order**, use the up and down arrows to the left of the image.
