

2nd September

Justin Garner, *The Small World of Macro Photography*.

The talk will explore the small world of macro photography. Justin will show images of flowers, plants, insects and small objects and how he photographs them.

9th September

Mike Martin, AFIAP AWPf. *It's not what you see, it's what you make*

23rd September

7th October

21st October

Janet Haines, ARPS FIPF EFIAP GPSA DPAGB *Inside my Head*

Janet tells us that "I don't take picture, I makes pictures". In this talk Janet will present a variety of mages including some successful panels of her recent work.

4th November

David Garthwaite *Fine Art Work Flow*

David will walk us step by step through his work flow for creating striking black and white fine art images. He will craft a fine art image from RAW to finished, explaining the tools he is using and then go into some of the theory of how to produce the images.

11th November

Andy Phillips *The Inner Landscape*.

Andy subtitles this talk as "Photographing Still life with a Difference". This is a 90 minute talk of Andy's take on Still Life. He says "Anyone can do this technique and it doesn't matter if you only have basic kit".

25th November

Ken Scott ARPS *Touching the Light*

In this talk, Ken, who has 40 years photographic experience, will share some principles and stories for BEING in the landscape, for being attuned to light and for going with your own flow as a photographer.

9th December

Dave Russell AFIAP *A-Z of Imaging*

Dave's talk will run through the alphabet from A to Z with at least one topic for each letter. It includes landscapes, people pictures, natural history, travel, creative and much more.
